


BI Office Missing Data Wizard

BI Office **Missing Data Wizard** is a mini application designed to help end users update content after changes are made to underlying data models. Corrections can be made to cube structures, custom MDX statements used in queries, and custom element definitions covering both members and sets.

► Launch the Missing Data Wizard


From the **Backstage**, the wizard can be launched three different ways. Click on the content search **menu** button in the content organizer panel.



Launch from the **Missing Data Wizard** button in the metadata panel.

Click on a book or dashboard within a folder to bring up its context menu. Click the **Missing Data Wizard** button.


► Choose Items for Validation



Select which **items** the wizard will validate for existence in the selected data model. Those items range from; dimensions, hierarchies, levels, sets and members, MDX queries, Custom Elements, or all of the above. Also choose to Refresh the Models Metadata. Click **Next**.

Resolve Issues

If the Missing Data Wizard finds any missing content or issues with the model, its **content type** and **name** will appear.



For each missing item or issue, the wizard provides a **resolution** to correct it.


Choose to apply the same **resolution** to all identical issues found in other content in the Missing Data Wizard's search cache.

Notice the item's basic **metadata** listed under it.


View the active **summary** of issues in the model. See the summary **update** as each item is resolved.



After resolving an issue click **Next** to move on, or **Skip** to the next issue.



See a summary of all fixed issues. Click **Apply**.



Notice the success **message** appear. Click **Close**. The Data Discovery report containing the fixed model will now open correctly.
